A Message *from the Director*

Looking back on this year it was not what any of us expected. It has been difficult to witness the devastating impact COVID-19 has had on our community. Some have lost loved ones while others struggle financially. Our staff at the Haven have had to pivot which has allowed us to continue to serve our community and adapt to their growing needs.

Haven on the Queensway has received an incredible amount of support which has allowed us to continue to provide our services to the most vulnerable. Our food bank has been impacted the most with a client increase of over 100% creating a greater need for food donations. The Haven aims to provide at least 3 days worth of food per week based on family size.

Our Haven's closet continues to be an essential service during these challenging times as we provide much needed clothing free of charge to families and individuals in need.

Rain or shine our Hope with Wheels program has maintained a strong presence in the community and has not only continued to provide food, hygiene kits, and sleeping bags on Tuesdays but has increased their nights to Thursdays as well.

It has been especially hard for our seniors, many of whom have been isolated and are unable to meet with friends and family. Marta and our Haven helping seniors' volunteers have maintained contact with our seniors by making weekly calls and delivery of grocery items and art kits.

I am so grateful for the many ways our community has responded with both financial and food donations as well as offers to volunteer. In these tough times, I have found solace in the countless amazing stories of how our services have been able to provide comfort and security in small and big ways. *(Keep reading to hear the incredible stories).*

The way we work may look different right now, but I am grateful that with your support, our commitment to the most vulnerable people in our community hasn't changed.

Let's all remember to continue to maintain our distance, wear a mask, wash our hands and get tested if we are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms. We are all in this together!
